On behalf of the Traditional Karate Association of Silesia and the MUKS Bytom Karate Club I would like to invite you for the Silesia Cup - International Open Championship of Silesia in Traditional Karate. Silesia Cup will be held under the aegis of Traditional Karate Federation of Poland.

Silesia Cup will take place on 20th May 2012 in Bytom – in the “Na Skarpie” Sports Hall. Silesia Cup will be held within Martial Arts Weekend.

As usual, all participants will receive small gifts, and the winners will be granted with attractive prizes such as mp3 players, T-shirts, backpacks.

We have prepared a special surprise for the Most Valuable Competitor of the Silesia Cup. He or she will receive Japanese sword - *katana* (sharp, combat), forged especially for the Silesia Cup by artist blacksmith, according to the original technology.

Last year, in Silesia Cup took part around 250 competitors from 23 clubs from the Czech Republic, UK and Poland - among them many champions and medalists from Poland, Czech Republic, Europe and other parts of the world. Silesia Cup will be held under the auspices of Silesian Voivode and Mayor of Bytom.

I would like to mention, that our ambition (and many years of practice as well) is to manage the Silesia Cup smoothly, so we expect that it will run from 2 pm. to 6.30 pm.

Younger Juniors (1999-1997)

- Kata (Eliminations: Heian 1-5, flag judging system, Semi-Final and Final – competitor chooses: bassai dai, ji-on, Kan-ku dai, en-pi, (different in Final and Semi-Final) - point judging system.
- Kumite (Girls: Ko-Go Kumite, Boys: Eliminations - Ko-Go Kumite, Semi-Final and Final - Jiyu-Kumite)

Older Juniors (1996-1994)

- Kata (any Kata from ITKF list, point judging system (different Kata in Final and Semi-Final)
- Kumite (Girls: Ko-Go Kumite, Boys: Jiyu-Kumite)

Seniors (1993 and older)

- Kata (any Kata from ITKF list, point judging system (different Kata in Final and Semi-Final)
- Kumite (Women: Ko-Go Kumite, Man: jiyu-kumite)

In each group and category boys and girls compete separately. The organizer reserves the right to combine the various groups due to shortage of competitors. Applications should be sent via mail sowaj@interia.pl to 11th May 2012. To the 11th May entry fee, for each competition, is 15 zloty (about 3,5 euro). After that date entry fee is doubled.

All competitors should have current physical examinations and insurance.
